## DLP CHEAT SHEET



## Effective praise is always specific!



- Ties back to a *particular* action, behaviour, attitude or accomplishment that you observed/noticed
- Gives <u>precise</u> information about what you liked, so there is empowerment to do/say it again
- It's more likely to be <u>believed</u>

## THE FORMULA FOR EFFECTIVE PRAISE:



the specific action that you saw/heard

the character trait you want to encourage

with sincerity

## FOR EXAMPLE:

ABE

Wow, Maddy! I see you are sitting exactly on your dot with hands in your lap and eyes on me.
You're a great listener! Keep that up!

PRAISE

Notice how precisely Maddy's actions are described. It's crystal clear exactly what she's doing that is great!

Being a "good listener" is a character trait. We name the character traits to help Maddy to recognize them in herself. It boosts Maddy's self esteem and it makes her more likely to listen well in future situations, too - like the next rotation or next class... or even at home or school.

The key here is that it must be said with sincerity (you have to mean it)... or else it doesn't work. This could also be a high five or expressing gratitude.
